

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Basic principle and commitment of the ECOFUEL (CYPRUS) LTD is to provide the appropriate working environment which ensures the health and safety of its employees and other persons likely to be affected by the activities of the company.

That policy is based on the following general principles and the OHSAS 18001:2007 standard:

- The provision and maintenance of facilities, management systems and work processes that are safe and risk free to the health and safety of the personnel
- To ensure that the health and safety of the employees is not affected by the use, handling, storage and transport of substances
- The provision of necessary information, instruction and training (competence).
- To eliminate the hazards and associated risks. If that cannot be achieved to apply appropriate procedures, preventive and protective measures
- To comply with the applicable laws and legislation and to implement management systems and procedures to ensure this compliance
- Assessment and measurement of risk at regular intervals and in particular after the implementation of corrective and / or preventive actions in order to ensure a continuous reduction of the risk
- Prevention of accidents and occupational diseases
- To provide the necessary resources (staff training, personal protective equipment, emergency response plan) to maintain the health and safety of the personnel

To achieve the above, ECOFUEL has designed, developed and implemented a Health and Safety Management System which documents the Organization, Responsibilities, Arrangements, Procedures, Regulations and Work Instructions. ECOFUEL is committed to monitor and continuously improve the performance of the Health and Safety Management System.

ECOFUEL sets measurable objectives for the Health and Safety, at corporate and operational department levels. These objectives are established and evaluated for their degree of achievement in the context of the 'Review of Health and Safety System' by the Management of ECOFUEL.
